



Fast knitted hat and mittens

50% Angora / 50% Merino

Wool from our own angora rabbits



©Design:

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Size: Hat: S (M, L) Mittens: One Size

Needles: U.S. size 10 / 6 mm: straight + 2 dpn

Yarn: 50% angora / 50% 50% angora/50% merino wool wool (6.5 yd/6 m / 1 gram from AngoraGarnet = (1.65 yd/1.5 m / 1 gram with four strands)

Yarn amounts: Hat 70 (90, 110) gram, mittens 85-100g

Yarn amounts for hat and mittens in color as suggested:

White, 100g; beige, 100g; gray 100g and green, 50g.

Gauge: 16 sts x 30 rows = 4 x 4 in / 10 x 10 cm garter stitch holding four strands of yarn together.

The hat is knitted back and forth; garter stitch, the top of the hat and the mittens are knitted in the round dpn.

Hat:

Holding four strands tog CO 72 (80, 88) sts over 2 straight needles held together. Knit in garter stitches (Knit 1 row, purl 1 row) and change colors every 6th row for example:

6 rows	2 strands green	+ 2 strands beige yarn
6 rows	2 strands gray	+ 2 strands naturbeige garn
6 rows	2 strands gray	+ 2 strands vitt garn
6 rows	2 strands green	+ 2 strands vitt garn
6 rows	2 strands beige	+ 2 strands vitt garn
6 rows	2 strands beige	+ 2 strands naturgrått garn
6 rows	2 strands green	+ 2 strands naturgrått garn
6 rows	2 strands white	+ 2 strands turgrått garn
6 rows	2 strands white	+ 2 strands naturbeige garn

Repeat throughout.

Knit back and forth straight for 5.5 (6, 7) in / 14 (16, 18) cm.

Knit in the round decreasing as follow:

knit 6sts, k2 tog, k6. k2 tog until the end of the round. Purl one row.

knit 5sts, k2 tog, k5. k2 tog until the end of the round. Purl one row.

knit 4sts, k2 tog, k4. k2 tog until the end of the round. Purl one row.

Decrease as established with 1 fewer stitches between the decreases on every other round until 11 sts remain.

Finish with a purl round and pull the yarn through the 11 stitches. Darn in the end on the inside of the hat.

Seem back.

Mittens:

Holding four strands tog CO 24 sts over 2 dpn held together. Carefully remove extra dpn and divide sts evenly onto dpn. Join in a circle, being careful not to twist cast-on row. Work in ribbing: P1, K1 for 18 rows. Change colors as described under the hat.

Knit one row and at the same time increase 1 st (for the thumb gusset) in the first stitch. Increase also in the 3rd, 7th, 11th, 15th, 19th and 23rd stitch. You now have 31 sts. P1 round, K1 round, P1 round.

Continue in garter stitches throughout.

Thumb Gusset: On the next round, increase 1 st each in the 1st and last sts for the thumb gusset (these 4 sts are the beginning of the thumb gusset). Increase 1 st at each side of the gusset on every 3rd round another 4 times. You now have 12 sts for the thumb gusset and 29 sts for the hand. Place the 12 thumb sts on a holder.

Hand: So that you'll have 32 sts for the hand, CO 3 st at end of next round (over the thumb). Knit until 1½ in / 3 cm from desired length.

Top Shaping: Knit in the round decreasing as follow:

Knit 2 sts, k2 tog, K2. k2 tog until the end of the round. Purl one row.

Knit 1 sts, k2 tog, k1. k2 tog until the end of the round. Purl one row.

K2 tog until the end of the round. Finish with a purl round and pull the yarn through the 8 stitches.

Thumb: Place the 12 thumb sts on dpn and pick up and knit 4 sts along top of thumbhole = 16 sts total. Divide sts evenly onto dpn and work until ¾ in / 2 cm from desired length.

Knit 2 sts, k2 tog, K2. k2 tog until the end of the round. Purl one row.

knit 1 sts, k2 tog, k1. k2 tog until the end of the round. Purl one row.

k2 tog until the end of the round. Finish with a purl round and pull the yarn through the 8 stitches.

Make the second mitten the same way.

Why not knit a scarf to match? For example CO 32 sts dpn U.S size 10 / 6 mm with four strands, the scarf will be appr. 8 in / 20 cm wide. Work garter stitches desired length.
