The following chart shows our strategic directions and outcomes. It has been our guide during 2019 .



1. Achieving Objectives - Physical

Our main income came from the 28 participants fees from the course: Diploma in Biodynamic Agriculture, and the membership fees. We have received new applications for membership that will increase the amount of fees. This new members are farmers from 3 different Peruvian regions, San Martin, Cuzco and Lambayeque, they are individuals and 1 cacao and coffee cooperative

2. Raise awareness of the proposal and results - Eteric

The institutional management has been improved, our legal status and financial processes are updated, and ABD Peru members are informed about it. Our service of selling preparados is still low and demand based. The same is with the training services.

3. Ensure performance - Animic

Participants from 8 different Latin American countries were enrolled in the Diploma Course. Pedagogically, technical and financially it was our major success. Twelve experts in different biodynamic and anthroposophy themes, 11 months (48 weeks), 11 Webinars and 20 development projects designed by participants are some highlights of the Diploma Course.

The Nutrition in Mountain Agroecosystems (NMA) an IFOAM project was successfully implemented in 4 different regions (Piura, Ayacucho, Lima and Cuzco) and the ABD Peru administered the project.

A delegation of 12 Peruvian ABD member assisted and actively participated in the 2019 Congress of the Americas held in San Miguel de Allende, Mexico.

We succeeded in increasing the number of events throughout the year promoting new membership, at the last December 2019 gathering, 60 participants attended.

4. Broader consciousness - Spiritual

After the implementation of the Biodynamic Agriculture Diploma we are aware that we want to continue offering this formative processes. We are challenged to train our own members so they become trainers in Biodynamic agriculture. We have a network of more than 50 persons interested in our activities.

NUTRITION IN MOUNTAIN AGROECOSYSTEMS (NMA)

MAAN platform is well governed and capacities of RSPs are enhanced.

Evidence of participation in MAAN, on-line activities, social networks (NMA facebook) reaching out 80,000 agents of change.

4 Capacity Development Programs were implemented in 4 different regions (Piura, Ayacucho, Lima and Cuzco)

The residential phase of all four CDPs, were 3 full days facilitated by ToTs (team of trainers) for each PDC with the support of NMA staff (country manager and RSP dynamizer). Webinars: 25 webinars have been done and additional skype meetings to strengthen capacities of ToTs and RSPs. Webinars contents addressed the need of Baselines, MAAN Platform user, Microinterventions, Nutrition, Agroecology and Biodynamic Agriculture, and Honest Food Campaign.
