Information to all coaches and participants at the SWIM OPEN STOCKHOLM 12/4 – 15/4, 2019.

Hospitality desk: In Clarion Hotel you will meet our Hospitality desks from morning to bedtime. At Quality Globe every evening 18.00-20.00. You can reach the Hospitality manager, **Marie Sparrman** at any time from arrival until departure at +46 70 780 73 78 if the desk is unmanned.

Transfer: All foreign participants using the official Swim Open hotel reservation get free transfer from Arlanda to Clarion on Wednesday and Thursday and back on Monday/Thursday. Look for SWIM OPEN signs from our STAFF after you passed the customer, they have nice black shirts. For departure times at departure day please check your transfer with the Hospitality desks. If you need transfer other dates our hospitality desk or the Swim Open Bureau can help you with information and booking.

The fastest five heats of each event will be swum at the start of the morning session. After completion of all fastest heats, other heats of each event will be conducted in usual order, called the b-flight. All heats except the final heat in 800 and 1500 freestyle will be swum at the end of the morning session. **All 100/200 events in the morning session** will start with a Swedish junior team qualifying heat.

Team Leaders meeting:

A team leader from each country/club and Swedish club teams are required to attend the Team Representatives Meeting to be held at Eriksdalsbadet **Thursday April 11, 18.00** in the big conference room on the second floor from the 25 m pool, beside Swim Open Bureau.

Withdrawals:

You can mail in your withdrawals in ahead to Meet Director Kenneth.Magnusson@svensksimidrott.se. Last time for withdrawals heats and timed finals shall be made at the team leaders meeting. Withdrawals for the finals shall be made at the Swim Open Bureau not later than 30 minutes after the end of each event.

800/1500 m freestyle: The events will be seeded and swum as timed finals. The last heat will be swum during the A – finals and the rest during the trials.

Accreditation:

All participants, coaches & staff will get an personal accreditation card that must be shown in order **to get entrance to the swimming centre**, Eriksdalsbadet. The card shall be visible worn inside the venue. **The card also is needed for the meals at the hotel Clarion and Quality Globe Hotel.**

Dressing room:

In the dressing rooms you will find lockers. They must be closed with a padlock. **Bring your own padlock.** Observe two persons/locker, otherwise the number of lockers won't be enough.

S Team Stands:

Reserved seating for the participants is located on the pool deck.

Opening ceremony: There will be a short opening ceremony on Friday 12 of April at 17.45.

Prize ceremony: Prize ceremony will be held. Please pick up Prize Ceremony Scheme for everyday at the Swim Open Bureau. We hereby remind all participants to observe **if they do not show up** at the prize ceremony they will **not receive any medal or prize money**.

Prize money: In each event:
Winner € 600
Second € 300
Third € 100

In case of a tie in any race, the prize money shall be shared (e.g. if there are two 1st places, then no 2nd place prize money will be awarded). The total of € 900 will be equally shared between the two (2) winners, (that is € 450 each.)

The top three female and male performances during the whole event, (counting the three best results from FINA's table) gets prize money:

First place € 7500
Second place € 5000
Third place € 2500

Winners of prize money shall provide banking information to the organizing committee in Swim Open Bureau during the evening session by using the form that have been received at the prize ceremony. **Attn. – Bring passports!**

Callroom: Both in B/C – finals and in A – finals callroom will be used. All athletes shall be in callroom minimum 10 minutes before racetime.
A - finalist get Bibs, these must be worn fully visible during Athletes introduction at the Finals and award ceremonies.

Clothes baskets: Behind each lane there will be a basket for clothes. During the trials the baskets will remain on the pool deck.
During the B/C – and A – finals the baskets will be carried away after each start and placed in the room beside the 25 m pool. Missing clothes will be picked-up after each day and will be beside the Swim Open Coach Café at the 25 m pool.

Results: The results will be posted at the wall in the 25 m pool and also in the 50 m pool. You can also go to the Swim Open Bureau and pick up results. You also find them on <https://www.livetiming.se/results.php?cid=4302>

Medical: A doctor will be available during the competition. If you need to contact a hospital or any other medical institution, the doctor and the SWIM OPEN Bureau will help you.

Doping tests: The doping tests will be held in a dressing room in the end of the corridor to the 25 m pool.

Entrance to the arena:

The participants are obliged to use the SWIM OPEN entrance at the Eriksdalsbadet. Signs will show the way.
