Hospitality desk: In Clarion Hotel you will meet our Hospitality desks from morning to bedtime from the 6th of April. You can reach the Hospitality manager, **Malin Borensjö** at any time from arrival until departure at +46 73 629 94 47 if the desk is unmanned.

Transfer: All foreign participants using the official Swim Open hotel reservation get free transfer from Arlanda to Clarion. Look for **SWIM OPEN signs** from our STAFF after you passed the customer, they have nice black shirts with the Swim Open Logo in gold of course. For departure times at departure day please check your transfer with the Hospitality desks. If you need transfer other dates our Hospitality Desk can help you with information and booking.

Entrance to the arena: The participants are obliged to use the SWIM OPEN entrance at the Eriksdalsbadet. Signs will show the way.

	A – Finals	18.00 all days

This particular year we have share the morning sessions in two flights, A- and B with 30 minutes paus between to minimize the number of athletes. See the attached Time Schedule for each day. All heats except the final heat in 800 and 1500 freestyle will be swum at the end of the morning session.

Team Leaders meeting:

Because of the covid-19 situation and restrictions a Team Leaders Meeting will not be arranged. If you have any kind of question before the event don't hesitate contact Swim Open manager dennis.fredriksson@svensksimidrott.se or call +46 708 74 95 03.

Withdrawals:

You can mail in your withdrawals in ahead to Meet Director Kenneth.Magnusson@svensksimidrott.se. Last time for withdrawals heats and timed finals shall be made **latest 7 of April 18:00**. Withdrawals for the finals shall be made using the APP you will receive before the event, an easy way to do eventually withdrawals.

800/1500 m freestyle: The events will be seeded and swum as timed finals. The last heat will be swum during the A – finals and the rest during the trials.

A – B – C finals: Because of the low number of athletes in some events we have decide to only swim the B – and C – finals if there are at least 4 participants in the event. It may concern only event 20, 21, 23 and 25.

Accreditation:

All participants, coaches & staff will get a personal accreditation card that must be shown all the time in order **to get entrance to the swimming centre**, Eriksdalsbadet and Clarion Hotel. The card shall be visible worn visible all the time. **The card also is needed for the meals at the hotel Clarion.**

Dressing room:

In the dressing rooms you will find lockers. They must be closed with a padlock. **Bring your own padlock.** This year we recommend all athletes to change up at the rooms because of the restrictions in numbers (see signs on the walls/doors in each dressing room).

Team Stands:

Unfortunately, not this year, all athletes must be in the warm-up area if they are not in the competition mode. **Only coaches are allowed at the stand.**

Opening ceremony:

This unusual year with no audience we just have a small "welcome" in the 50 m pool Thursday 8 of April at around 17:55

Prize ceremony: This year no prize ceremony will be held because of our infection preventive program.

Prize money: In each event:
Winner € 200
Second € 100
Third € 50

In case of a tie in any race, the prize money shall be shared (e.g. if there are two 1st places, then no 2nd place prize money will be awarded). The total of € 300 will be equally shared between the two (2) winners, (that is € 150 each.)

Winners of prize money goes to the Swim Open Bureau and bring their passport and banking information to the organizing committee in Swim Open Bureau during/after the evening session.

Callroom: Not this year because of restrictions, but instead we will mark different areas the swimmers will enter before each event. Swimmers must wear the accommodation card visible all the time before the race so our staff can help/coordinate if needed.

Clothes baskets: Behind each lane there will be a basket for clothes. After each heat you find your basket at **C** in the Arena plan. (Just beside the pool). Missing clothes will be picked-up after each day and will be beside the Swim Open Bureau.

Results: The results will only be announced digitally to avoid crowds, see the results at <https://www.livetiming.se/results.php?cid=5782?&lang=2>. Coaches can also go to the Swim Open Bureau and pick up results.

Medical: A doctor, Mrs Charlotte Wallin, will be available during the competition, + 46 70 939 60 19. She also has AG tests if needed. If you need to contact a hospital or any other medical institution, the doctor and the SWIM OPEN Bureau will help you.

Health declaration: All teams must daily do a Health Declaration of all participants and leave to the Hospitality Desk. See attached Health Declaration Sheet.

Doping tests: The unannounced doping tests will be held in a dressing room in the end of the corridor to the 25 m pool.

Dining: Meals will be served at Clarion Hotel in different slot times, see more information in the **MEALS** sheet. **Att. No meals will be served after 20:00 according the Swedish Covid-19 rules.**

At all meals all participations must show their accreditations.
