The 2020 edition of SLAM! will look at how specialisation can offer translators the opportunity to secure a customer base and the ability to thrive going into the future.

Submit your proposal for a presentation with **clear value and relevance** for **experienced** language industry professionals. We are interested in proposals both from within and outside of Scandinavia and from within and outside of the language industry.

### Requirements

- 1. Proposal:** Brief description of presentation topic with clear objectives for what attendees will learn and how they can apply this knowledge. The proposal must be related to the conference theme.
- 2. Bio:** You must include a brief bio of the speaker(s).
- 3. Language:** The written proposal and the presentation must be in English.
- 4. Technical requirements:** Any technical equipment required for your presentation must be listed in your proposal.
- 5. Length:** Presentations should be 40–45 minutes in length.
- 6. Deadline:** Complete proposals must be sent by email to [mail@slamconf.com](mailto:mail@slamconf.com) and received by **26 February 2020**.
- 7. Selection:** The proposals incorporated into the final programme will be chosen at the discretion of the organising committee.
