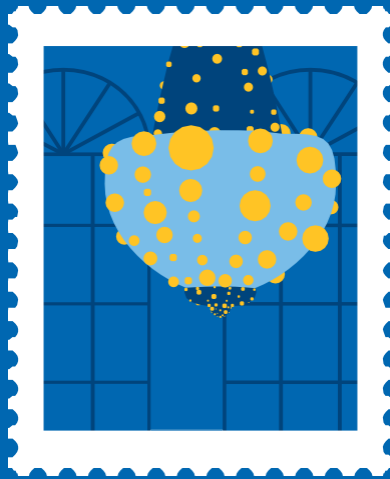

RDP CEREMONY THE ROLL OF DISTINGUISHED PHILATELISTS



The Roll of Distinguished Philatelists (RDP) is a prestigious international philatelic award, created by the Philatelic Congress of Great Britain in 1921. The Roll consists of pieces of parchment to which the signatories add their names. Being one of the highest and most prestigious honors in philately, the RDP recognizes achievement, research, publication and service. It was established in 1920, and in 1921, King George V was the first to sign the roll.

Set in the Grand Hôtel in the Hall of Mirrors – Spegelsalen.
In this room the first Nobel Prize ceremony and banquet took place in 1901.
