

Nordic researchers meeting – second call March 26th 2021

Frontiers in Nordic Sociology of Religion
Nordic researchers' meeting, June 7th 2021, digital via Zoom

Background

The 25th Nordic Conference on Sociology of Religion was planned to take place in Gothenburg 2020, but is postponed to 2022 due to the Corona pandemic. The aim of the Nordic researchers meeting June 7th 2021 is dual; *firstly* to provide an opportunity for Nordic researchers in sociology of religion to meet and update knowledge about what is going on in the respective countries, and *secondly* to constitute a new Nordic Association for the Sociology of Religion. This new organisation will be the responsible body for the biannual Nordic Conference on Sociology of Religion (NCSR) and the Nordic Journal of Religion and Society (NJRS). The meeting will be a digital meeting, and only one day, since it is unfortunately not possible to plan for a meeting in person.

Main content

The main part of the meeting will consist of 30 minute reports from Denmark, Finland, Norway and Sweden (and possibly Iceland) followed by 15 minutes for questions/discussion. The reports are expected to present: a) ongoing and planned research, projects etc., b) other information, news, publications, activities etc. of common interest.

Time and place

Monday June 7th 09.00 – 15.30 followed by a special meeting for Nordic doctoral students.
