Jan Olof Olsson worked as a journalist at Dagens Nyheter in Stockholm from 1945 to 1974. Under the signature of Jolo, he became a beloved reporter, travel writer and columnist. He was also the author of some forty books. Jolo was a gifted writer and a talented observer, with a keen eye for odd, yet characteristic details. One of his specialties was essays on cultural history.

Jolosällskapet is a Swedish literary society dedicated to Jan Olof Olsson (1920–1974). The society was formed on May 10, 1997, with the aim of promoting Jolo's journalism and literary works through meetings, seminars, journeys and compilations of Jolo texts into books and booklets.
