



## Para-Pole Video preliminary criteria – WPSC 2017

### ***Video submission:***

1. Routines must be submitted in accordance to the Amateur rules in the Code of points.
2. The routine for para-pole video preliminaries must be a minimum of three minutes and twenty seconds (3:20) to a maximum of three minutes and thirty seconds (3:30) in duration.
3. Choreography, costume, music, hair and makeup used in video must correspond to rules stated in IPSF National Rules and Regulations which in the back of the Code of Points.
4. The video must be filmed with no cuts and with good lighting conditions.
5. Videos filmed in dark rooms or with any kind of filter will not be accepted.
6. No distracting sounds such as conversation in the background are permitted.
7. No other persons besides the applicant are to be visible.
8. The video must be filmed upright. Videos turned sideways or upside down will not be accepted.
9. The video must be submitted online via a public [www.youtube.com](http://www.youtube.com) link and sent to [athletes@polesports.org](mailto:athletes@polesports.org).
10. The video must be clearly labelled with the athlete's full name, category and WPSC17.
11. Both spinning and static poles must be used in the video in the correct positions.
12. A correctly filled in compulsory form with the nine (9) chosen elements and a correctly filled in technical bonus score form, is to be submitted with the link to the video. For updates and current criteria see Code of Points.
13. Videos will only be judged if applications exceed the number of finalists permitted.
14. Deadlines for applications and videos:
  - Applications close 11<sup>th</sup> May
  - Finalists announced 1<sup>st</sup> June
